Directed by Angus Smith of the Orlando Consort, who is also a Stainer and Bell Choral Ambassador

Saturday June 18th 2022, at Thorverton Parish Church of St. Thomas of Canterbury, Thorverton, Devon, EX5 5NU, from 10.30 am to 4.30 pm (arrival and coffee from 10 am).

The day will cover an inspiring range of unaccompanied choral music, ranging from an anonymous 11th century Alleluia to Byrd's Veni, sancte spiritus and Miserere mihi Domine, by way of Dunstaple, Taverner and Parsons. Thanks to the involvement of Stainer and Bell, every participant will receive a bound copy of all the music, which they may keep.

Angus Smith studied at St John's College, Cambridge, where he was a choral scholar, after which he won a scholarship to train at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama. He has performed with many ensembles specialising in early music, including the Gabrieli, Taverner, and Orlando Consorts, Tallis Scholars, The Sixteen, the Academy of Ancient Music, the English Concert, the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment, the Monteverdi Choir and the Ensemble Vocal Européen. Angus is today best known as a member of the Orlando Consort, for whom he also acts as the main programme planner.
